

REPLACING OF THE MULTIFOCAL LENS TO MONOFOCAL IS NOT THE ONLY ONE WAY TO IMPROVE QUALITY OF VISION IN PATIENTS WITH TOO LARGE PUPIL. A CASES REPORT

Purpose: To present 2 cases (eyes) whom multifocal lens (Mplus) was implanted and who have started to complain for bad quality of vision after cataract surgery. An examination has revealed too large pupil. Patients were qualified to decrease surgically the size of the pupil. Methods: Surgical decrease of the pupil size was done. In one eye the pupil is still working. In the second eye the pupil was decreased permanently. Results: An improvement of a quality of vision were achieved in both cases. Conclusions: Replacing of multifocal to monofocal lenses is not the only way to improve a quality of vision in patients who have too large pupil. Financial Disclosure: No
