

DELIVERIES IN BREECH PRESENTATION-SHORT REVIEW

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Introduction: 3-6% of the fetuses at term will be in breech presentation. Facing with this situation we deal with a lot of controversies related to the mode of delivery. Aim: To evaluate all patients with breech presentation fetuses, hospitalized and delivered at the University clinic for obstetrics and gynecology, in order to start a process of developing a standardized protocol for every day management of breech presentation. Results: During the year 2015 there were a total of 5557 deliveries at our institution, of which 3629 (65.31%) were vaginal deliveries and 1928 (34.69%) were cesarean sections. From the total number of deliveries 332 (5.9%) were fetuses in breech presentation., from which 87 (26.2%) were delivered vaginally and 245 (73.8%) with cesarean section. According to the parity 190 (57.22%) were nulliparous and 142 (42.77%) were multiparous. The percentage of vaginal versus operative deliveries in these two groups were quite similar. Conclusion: To evaluate all pregnancies with breech presentation fetuses and to promote the need of specialized institutional protocol for breech presentation management and mode of delivery.
