

Dr. Ikram is associate professor and head of neuro-epidemiologic research at the department of Epidemiology, Erasmus MC Rotterdam, the Netherlands. He also carries affiliations with the departments of Radiology and Neurology. He is principal investigator of neurologic diseases in the Rotterdam Study and principal investigator of the Rotterdam Scan Study. He is also a key collaborator in the CHARGE (Cohorts for Heart and Aging Research in Genomic Epidemiology) consortium. His research focuses on investigating the etiology of neurologic diseases in the elderly, with a particular focus on dementia, Alzheimer disease, stroke, and Parkinson disease. Dr. Ikram has published over 240 international scientific papers (H-index = 38).
