

Anders Wallin is an internationally recognized researcher in the field of clinical dementia research. His research deals with Alzheimer's disease, vascular cognitive impairment especially subcortical vascular disease, cerebrospinal fluid biomarkers, MRI, neuropsychology, diagnostics and classification. He has participated in several trials using pharmacological agents. He is leader of the ongoing Gothenburg MCI study, which is a longitudinal, clinical-pathophysiological study about the early and manifest phases of the Alzheimer – subcortical vascular disease spectrum in a memory clinic setting. Anders Wallin has published around 400 papers and is listed among the Top 100 investigators in the field of Alzheimer's disease research. His H-index is 57 (Scopus, 2013).
