Robert Benamouzig is Professor of Gastroenterology and Chief of Gastroenterology department at the Avicenne hospital. This department includes general gastroenterology, digestive oncology, endoscopy as functional dieases units and the Clinical Research Centre of CRNH (Centre de Recherche en Nutrition Humaine) d'Ile de France. He teaches at the University Paris 13, for the DES of Gastroenterology and IUD for digestive oncology as well as various Master. He coordinates the oncogenetic IUD. He has conducted numerous studies on the role of the digestive tract on the prevention of colorectal cancer, digestive physiology and in the feeding behavior. He was principal investigator of over 50 clinical studies and had more than 130 original articles in journals with referees. He was Technical Advisor to the Director General of Health for the development of colon cancer screening in France and the drug policy of 2000 to 2006. He is a member of various institutional actions (Technical Group Gastroenterology and Nutrition AFSSAPS, HAS, DGS). He is a member of the board of the National Society of Gastroenterology, the French Federation of Societies of Digestive Diseases and UEGF.
