Alan C Moses was educated at Duke University and Washington University School of Medicine and received medical training at Barnes Hospital, the National Institutes of Health, and Tufts-New England Medical Center. He is board certified in Internal Medicine, Endocrinology and Metabolism. He worked for 23 years at Harvard Medical School affiliated institutions where he rose to the rank of Professor of Medicine. Prior to joining Novo Nordisk Dr Moses served as Senior Vice President and Chief Medical Officer of the Joslin Diabetes Center.



He has written over 100 peer-reviewed articles on the treatment of diabetes and has been recognized both locally and nationally for his research in diabetes and growth factors. His research interests have been in endocrine cell growth in response to peptide growth factors, the pathophysiology of severe insulin resistance and novel treatments for diabetes mellitus.

Since joining Novo Nordisk in 2004, Dr Moses has held positions of increasing responsibility in Clinical Development and Medical Affairs and now serves as Senior Vice President and Global Chief Medical Officer. In August 2013, Dr Moses relocated to Denmark to be more fully integrated into global corporate decision-making. In his role as GCMO, he has responsibilities across the full spectrum of Novo Nordisk's diabetes focus from drug discovery, through drug development and the implications of diabetes for the company and for patients, healthcare professionals and for healthcare systems.
