

Dr Karine Lacombe, M.D., PhD.

Karine Lacombe is currently holding the position of assistant professor in the infectious and tropical diseases department of Saint-Antoine Hospital (AP-HP), Paris – France. She teaches infectious diseases and public health in numerous universities and schools around France, Europe, Sub Saharan Africa, India and Vietnam. She is involved in the clinical and therapeutical management of HIV-infected patients care at the inpatient and outpatient clinic of the hospital. As part of her academic work, she developed clinical research on the issues of HIV-hepatitis co-infections and co-morbidities associated with the use of antiretrovirals, in relation with INSERM research teams. She is the main authors of over 50 peer-reviewed publications and book chapters on these subjects. She has an MPH in public health and evaluation of health actions and a PhD in epidemiology obtained at the Pierre et Marie Curie University of Sciences, in Paris.
