Michael R. Sperling, M.D., is Baldwin Keyes Professor of Neurology and Vice Chair for Research at Thomas Jefferson University. He is an internationally known clinician scientist in the field of epilepsy, known particularly for his work in the field of epilepsy surgery and electrophysiology. He has published over 230 peer-reviewed papers, over 80 book chapters and reviews, and three books. He is presently Editor-in-Chief of Epilepsia and is a former president of the American Clinical Neurophysiology Society and the Philadelphia Neurological Society. He is active in the American Epilepsy Society and International League Against Epilepsy.
