

Jacek Losy is a professor of Neurology and Head of the Department of Clinical Neuroimmunology, Chair of Neurology, University School of Medicine in Poznan. As a young scientist he was awarded Jacqueline du Pré fellowship from the Multiple Sclerosis International Federation (MSIF). He worked in the Karolinska Institute and in the Institute for Basic Research in Developmental Disabilities in New York, USA. He published over 100 papers, in leading international journal, mainly in the field of neuroimmunology concentrating on the role of cytokines, adhesion molecules and chemokines in MS and on the inflammatory response in stroke. Prof. Losy was one of the founders of the Polish Multiple Sclerosis Society and served for many years as a chairman of the Medical Advisory Board of this Society. He is also a member of the International Medical & Scientific Board MSIF. He is a delegate to the Neuroimmunology Panel of the European Academy of Neurology and serves also as a chairman of MS Section Polish Neurological Society. He is also a guest reviewer of many international neurological journals. He is a member of the Editorial Board Multiple Sclerosis and Related Disorders.

Prof. Losy has organized several neuroimmunological conferences of national and international range promoting education in this field. He is a member of the World Federation of Neurology, European Academy of Neurology, International Society of Neuroimmunology, Polish Neurological Society and others.
