


CORE EXHIBITION


OPENING HOURS


Monday, Thursday, Friday: 10AM – 6PM

GUIDED TOURS


Guided tours of POLIN Museum are available in Polish and English.

Guided tours in other languages (Hebrew, French, German, Spanish, Russian) depend on the availability of the guides


Maximum number of people in a group on a guided tour is 25 (larger groups will be divided)

Larger groups must be divided into smaller ones with the maximum of 25 people in a group

Sub-groups will enter the exhibition 30 minutes apart, each with its own guide

VISITING INFORMATION

PAYMENT CANCELLATIONS RETURNS – GUIDED TOURS

- Payment can be made via the PayU system, 2 weeks prior to the visit.
- The reservation can be changed or cancelled not later than 5 days prior to the visit – we will reimburse the expenses. After this time, visitors will have to bear the cost of a guide.
- Visitors can buy additional tickets on the spot – provided that the total number of people in the group does not exceed 25.
- Unused tickets can be returned to the ticket office on the day of the visit – the refund will be made directly to the bank account (only guided visits).



RESERVATION

Please make reservations no less than 14 days prior to the date of planned visit, depending on the availability of museum guides.
