2010- Current Dr. Oved Daniel is a Clinical Neurologist and Headache Specialist and the Head of the Headache & Facial Pain Clinic at Laniado Medical Center in Israel. As a Clinical Neurologist, he was the Primary Investigator of many clinical trials for the treatment of a Migraine and Cluster Headache. He was elected as a board member of the European Academy of Neurology Scientific Panel Headache management group (EAN), and he is a renown Headache Specialist and a speaker in many international neurologic conferences around the world. Dr. Daniel is a Section Head of the International Controversies in Neurology conferences (CONy), along with Prof. Alan Rapoport, Past President of the International Headache Society, and the founder and CEO of the Annual International Headache Symposium in Israel (IHSI).

Dr. Daniel has been a key opinion leader in Israel in this field and was rated by the FORBES as one of the best Neurologists in Israel in 2018.
